Dear Sisters & Brothers in Christ,

On Sunday May 23<sup>rd</sup> we celebrated Pentecost Sunday, fifty days after Easter when the Holy Spirit descended by a rush of wind and tongues like fire upon those gathered who became the first church.

The season of Pentecost is an exceptionally long taking us through summer into fall and ends on November  $21^{st}$  with Christ the King Sunday. The liturgical color for Pentecost is green and is known as the growing season of the church. Jesus uses many analogy stories related to growth which are read during this time frame, especially early in the season of Pentecost.

We might be able to relate to this growth theme as well, as many have started gardens, for some it's another year added onto many, but for others it may be the very first garden you are planting. Either way, at some point trial and error occurs as each season in never the same.

As we come back together for in person church in the sanctuary, for some it is the first time returning, yet others have come back gradually to the Family Center and some are not yet ready to return. With the ever rapidly changing guidelines from the CDC, those of us in the leadership roles are finding it to be a time of trial and error as well (as this entire past year has been!). We pray during this time that you find it to be a time of grace given freely and abundantly.

Pentecost 2021 will also be a time of listening to the Holy Spirit to see where the Spirit will call us to do and be the church perhaps in new ways; ways never thought of before (while still holding on to some traditional familiar ways). For instance, we intend to continue to livestream services, a gift brought to us because of the situation with covid. Livestreaming has extended our community of faith near and far, to members who moved away due to life situations and to those who have other virtual connections to our members who join in faithfully each week for worship.

As the first century disciples were filled with the Holy Spirit, we too are filled with the Holy Spirit as it is with us every day, guiding us, asking us to be open to exploring our faith and to continue to grow the church in ways perhaps never thought of before.

I'm excited to be back in person and to begin to think about how we can continue to grow in our faith and BE the church once again both here at Jordan and beyond. What opportunities are you looking for to help grow your faith? How can we join together in growing the church?

May the Holy Spirit surround you and fill you with green growth of faith and love to help you root your faith deeply and share it abundantly to grow the church!




